

Topic 1 Using Ratios: Block 1

Essential Question: What do the three types of ratios mean?

A **ratio** is a comparison of two numbers by division. There are 3 ways to write a ratio.

Example:

6 cups of party mix to 2 cups of pretzels

- 1) In words:
- 2) With a symbol:
- 3) As a fraction:

All three ratios are read “six to two”

There are 2 types of ratios. Part to Part and Part to Whole.

Part to Part compares 2 pieces of a whole

Part to Whole compares a Part to the Whole.

Example: There is a class made up of 12 girls and 14 boys
